TRASH COLLECTION

All normal household trash must be placed in standard trash cans or tied plastic bags at the curb by 6 a.m. on Mondays and Thursdays. Because the amount of trash can vary from day to day on the route, AAA cannot guarantee an exact pickup time for each customer.

AAA will not pick up oil, paint, dead animals, toxic or flammable items, large tree stumps, containers or bundles weighing more than 50 pounds or longer than 6 feet, or any item that cannot be safely loaded and hauled away.

Special Items

Furniture, appliances, construction material, and other large miscellaneous household items require special handling. Please call AAA in advance to schedule this service. **There will be a minimum charge of \$25.00.** Ferrous metal/white goods such as stoves, refrigerators, washing machines, dryers, hot water tanks, etc. must be separated from the other trash and sent by Fairfax County to a special recycling center.

Holidays

AAA picks up on all holidays except New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. When your normal collection day falls on one of these holidays, your trash and/or recyclables will be collected on the next scheduled pickup day.

Inclement Weather

When AAA cannot make its collections due to unsafe road conditions due to snow and/or ice, usually there will be no makeup collection. Your trash and/or recyclables will be collected on the next scheduled pickup day. Visit the website for updated collection schedules.

RECYCLING COLLECTION

All recyclables must be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. on Thursdays. It is mandatory in Fairfax County to recycle newspaper, glass, aluminum and metal food cans, and plastics (No. 1 & 2). The recycling bins are the property of AAA and must be returned to them if Roxbury terminates its contract. They should be passed on to new owners when a unit is sold.

Newspapers & Magazines

Bundle your newspapers, magazines, & glossy inserts in paper bags or tie securely with strong twine. **Do not use plastic bags.** Bundles should be less than 20 lbs. Do not include telephone books, cardboard, or white paper.

Glass Bottles & Jars

Rinse out food residue and remove caps and lids. It is not necessary to remove labels or metal rings. Store in paper bags, boxes, or the AAA recycling bins. Do not include plate and window glass, pottery, light bulbs, Pyrex and ceramic dishes.

Metal & Aluminum Cans

Rinse all cans and store in paper bags, boxes, or recycling bins. Crush or fold if you want to save space. Do not include pots and pans, foil, pie tins, and scrap metal.

Plastics

Rinse all containers and store in paper bags, boxes, or recycling bins. Remove caps and lids. It is not necessary to remove labels. Include only plastics parked with No. 1 or 2.
